State leads nation in utilizing stimulus dollars

In a testament to the hard work of the Manchin administration and our Legislature, Vice President Joe Biden announced that West Virginia is leading the nation with the percentage of federal stimulus highway dollars being used. Our state has already put to work \$115.9 million in highway monies - or 78.6 percent - of the funds allocated to us.
